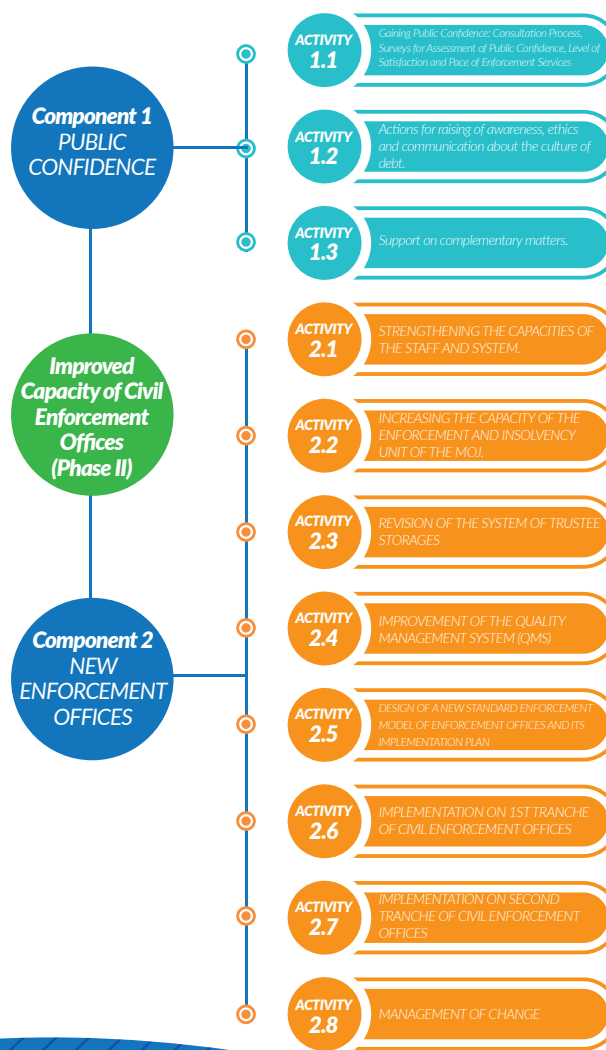


QUICKNESS, EFFICIENCY, LEGAL CERTAINTY, ECONOMIC IMPROVEMENT

The Turkish Ministry of Justice in partnership with the Spanish Ministry of Justice is developing this Twinning Project “**Improved Capacity of Civil Enforcement Offices**”, funded by the European Union

This is the second phase of a previous Project and it follows the indicative Strategy Paper for Turkey 2014-2020, Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance (IPA) II.

The key point is the need for continuation and strengthening of the process of reform of the Judiciary by developing and extending an innovative civil enforcement organisation concept.

The new model of Enforcement Offices is based on the following principles:

- 1) Concentration of enforcement tasks on one single enforcement office.
- 2) Specialization.
- 3) Standardization of practices.

Moreover, the Turkish Ministry of Justice aims to achieve the following two main results:

- 1) Implementation of new enforcement offices in large pilot provinces.
- 2) Increasing of public confidence in the enforcement system.

Improving the efficiency of the Judiciary is the main concern of the Turkish Government. Civil Court decisions are executed by the Enforcement Offices. The issue of improving the effectiveness of the enforcement services is the main axis of this legal reform process.

A modern organisation of Civil Courts ensures proper functioning of enforcement system in an effective, impartial, foreseeable and consistent manner.

It builds trust. Thus, the economy will improve and, as a result, domestic and foreign investment will grow up.
